Revised March 11, 2009

Chapter One – Standard One: Mission and Core Themes

Section I: Mission: [Three (3) pages maximum]

- a. Mission Statement
- b. Mission Core Themes
- c. Definition of Fulfillment of Mission and, Within that Definition, Interpretation of an Acceptable Threshold or the Extent of Mission Fulfillment.
- d. Date and Manner of Most Recent Review of Mission and Core Themes

Section II: Core Themes [For each Core Theme: [Maximum of three (3) pages per theme]

- a. Descriptive Title
- b. Goals or Intended Outcomes for the Core Theme
- c. Indicators of Achievement of the Core Theme’s Goals or Intended Outcomes
- d. Rationale as to Why the Indicators are Assessable and Meaningful Measures of Achievement of the Core Theme’s Goals or Intended Outcomes
