	70 - 100	MATH& 142, &148, & **151 ** MATH& 151 also requires a score of 70 on the trigonometry scale.

–Students who earn placement into ENGL& 101 on only ONE of the two tests may write a Decision Zone essay. Go to the Humanities office, Room 5390, or call 206-546-4770 to schedule an appointment.

–Students who earn placement below ENGL& 101 and one level apart (i.e. ENGL 080 in Reading ENGL 090 in Writing) should use the Reading score for placement.

–Students who earn scores two levels apart (i.e. ENGL 080 in Reading and ENGL 100 in Writing) should use the course in between the two for placement.

–Students who have been placed into ENGL& 101 at Edmonds CC may register for ENGL& 101 with proof of placement from Edmonds CC.
